JUNE 2, 2019 - THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

From the Desk of Father Jhakson

Brothers and sisters, today the Church celebrates the Ascension of Jesus into the heavens. A significant event for our life of faith, which marks the beginning of the Church. The Ascension will give way to the reception of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost.

This Sunday's reading, Luke, tells us the story of how it happened. It is striking that he wrote about this event, even though he wasn't present when it happened. However, the author wants to highlight the initial Christian community that took its first steps and that such an event was necessary to grow in the faith and in the testimony as a Church.

During this time of Easter, Jesus has been teaching and instructing us about the difficulties that we are going to experience, but that in spite of them we must remain faithful; He has indicated to us that the way in which others will recognize us as His disciples is the way in which we love one another; but, above all, He has promised us that He will never leave us alone, that He will send the Paraclete, the Holy Spirit, who will always guide us.

Today Jesus goes to heaven, and it doesn't mean that He'll not be with us anymore, or He'll be far away; On the contrary, now Jesus sends the Holy Spirit to stay in our midst forever.

In this event Jesus is revealing to us His return to His Father, from whence He came; but He's also showing us that going to heaven is going to God. Such homecoming is what should mark our life of faith on this day; the gospel says, "they returned joyfully to Jerusalem", but Luke means not only a physical place, but to return where our faith, our experience of God, had its beginning.

Today we must return to God, this need is becoming more urgent every day. Return to the experience of God in our lives. Jesus gives us his Holy Spirit to move forward, to remain faithful and thus definitely build the Church that God wants to establish in the world.

Hermanos y hermanas, hoy la Iglesia celebra la Ascensión de Jesús a los cielos. Un hecho significativo para nuestra vida de fe, que marca el inicio de la Iglesia. La Ascensión, dará paso al recibimiento del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés.

La lectura de este domingo, Lucas, nos relata la historia de cómo sucedió. Llama la atención que escriba sobre este hecho, aun cuando no estaba presente cuando sucedió. Sin embargo, el autor quiere poner de relieve a esa primera comunidad cristiana que iniciaba y daba sus primeros pasos y que tal acontecimiento era necesario para poder crecer en la fe y en el testimonio propio como Iglesia.

Durante este tiempo de Pascua Jesús nos ha ido enseñando e instruyendo sobre las dificultades que vamos a pasar, pero que a pesar de ellas debemos permanecer fieles; nos ha indicado que la forma en que nos reconocerán los demás como sus discípulos es la forma en que nos amemos los unos a los otros; pero, sobre todo, nos ha prometido que nunca nos dejará solos, que enviará al Paráclito, el Espíritu Santo, que nos guiará siempre.

Hoy Jesús sube al cielo, y ese hecho no significa que Jesús ahora no estará más con nosotros, o que estará alejado; al contrario, ahora Jesús, envía el Espíritu Santo para quedarse en medio de nosotros por siempre.

Jesús nos está revelando en esta acción que regresa a su Padre, de donde vino; pero, también nos está mostrando que ir al cielo, es ir a Dios. Ese regreso es lo que debe marcar nuestra vida de fe en este día; el evangelio dice que "ellos regresaron gozosos a Jerusalén", pero que Lucas quiere significar no sólo como un lugar físico, sino regresar donde nuestra fe, nuestra experiencia de Dios, tuvo su inicio.

Hoy debemos regresar a Dios, es cada día más urgente esta necesidad. Regresar a la experiencia de Dios en nuestras vidas. Jesús nos da su Espíritu Santo para seguir adelante, para permanecer fieles y así definitivamente construir la Iglesia que Dios quiere establecer en el mundo.
