MAY 26, 2019 - 6TH SUNDAY OF EASTER

From the Desk of Father Jhakson



Brothers and sisters, the Church is the community for those of us who believe in Christ, we share the same faith and we want to make present the Kingdom of God amid men, with the preaching and living of the Gospel. It's made up of sinful, limited men and women; but, the Holiness of our Church comes because its founder, its base, its origin is Holy: Jesus.

The readings of this Sunday invite us to think about our Church. How in its origins it also had its challenges and difficulties, but it also gives us the vision of what we should be and will be: a Church where there is no temple, because the temple will be God himself. For now, we are the Church that pilgrims in this world, which is directed towards its fullness.

We see this Sunday how the apostles face the second conflict of the emerging Church: "the circumcision or fulfillment of the Jewish law" to be part of it. Dialogue was the key to resolving the conflict. There was no position on one opinion on the other, but everything was based on focusing on what is most important for the community.

It is not the external, the empty fulfillment of the law, which will make it prevail, but the experience of something more internal and intimate: the experience of the teachings of Jesus, moving away from that which makes us impure, that is, sin.

The invitation of the apostles was to stop being slaves of the law, like the ancient Jews, but to focus on what is most important. Peter and Paul had already solved that discussion, emphasizing that the message of Jesus was not only for the Jews, but also for the pagans: the new law given by Jesus makes man free and not a slave.

That is the meaning of Peace that Jesus comes to give us. The security of knowing that we live according to His message, that He is the most important thing in our lives and that the fulfillment of the law, rubric or external act by itself, is empty and makes man a slave. Fulfilling the law of the Gospel, is aiming to be free and show that we really love Jesus.

Hermanos y hermanas, la Iglesia es la comunidad de los que creemos en Cristo, compartimos una misma fe y queremos hacer presente el Reino de Dios en medio de los hombres, con la predicación y vivencia del Evangelio. Ella está formada por hombres y mujeres pecadores, limitados; pero, la Santidad de nuestra Iglesia viene porque su fundador, su base, origen es Santo: Jesús.

Las lecturas de este domingo nos invitan a pensar en nuestra Iglesia. Cómo en sus orígenes también tuvo sus desafíos y dificultades, pero también nos da la visión de lo que debemos ser y será: una Iglesia donde no hay templo, porque el templo será Dios mismo. Por ahora, somos la Iglesia que peregrina en este mundo, que se dirige hacia su plenitud.

Vemos este domingo cómo los apóstoles afrontan el segundo conflicto de la Iglesia naciente: "la circuncisión o cumplimiento de la ley judía" para poder ser parte de ella. El diálogo fue la clave para resolver el conflicto. No hubo sobre posición de una opinión sobre la otra, sino que todo se fundamentó en enfocarse en lo más importante para la comunidad.

No es lo externo, el cumplimiento vacío de la ley, lo que hará que se prevalezca, sino que la vivencia de algo más interno e íntimo: la vivencia de las enseñanzas de Jesús, alejándose de aquello que nos hace impuros, es decir el pecado.

La invitación de los apóstoles era a no ser más esclavos de la ley, como los judíos antiguos, sino a enfocarse en lo que es más importante. Ya esa discusión Pedro y Pablo la habían solucionado, poniendo de relieve que el mensaje de Jesús era no sólo para los judíos, sino también para los paganos; que la ley nueva dada por Jesús, hace libre al hombre y no esclavo.

Ese es el sentido de la Paz que Jesús nos viene a dar. La seguridad de saber que vivimos según su mensaje, que Él es lo más importante en nuestras vidas y que el cumplimiento de la ley, rúbrica o acto externo por sí solo, es vacío y hace esclavo al hombre. Cumplir la ley del Evangelio, es apuntar a ser libre y demostrar que realmente amamos a Jesús.
