## The Lion's Roar

Dear friends,

The Eucharistic miracles we have been publishing in our bulletin state that Jesus is truly present in the Most Holy Eucharist. And there are many Eucharistic miracle stories. According to the story of the Desert Fathers in Egypt, when some monks decided to attend Mass together, the bread they put on the altar became a child. When a doubtful monk received the consecrated bread, he received a morsel of bloody flesh. He exclaimed, "Lord, I believe that this bread is your flesh and this chalice is your blood."

The doctrine of transubstantiation says that the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. This happens when the priest says over the bread "Take this, all of you, and eat it: This is my body, which will be given up for you." And when the priest says over the wine "Take this, all of you, and drink from it: This is the cup of my blood, the blood of the new and everlasting covenant. It will be shed for you and for all so that sins may be forgiven. Do this in memory of me."

Los milagros eucarísticos que venimos publicando en nuestro boletín afirman que Jesús está verdaderamente presente en la Santísima Eucaristía. Y hay muchas historias de milagros eucarísticos. Según la historia de los Padres del Desierto en Egipto, cuando unos monjes decidieron asistir juntos a Misa, el pan que pusieron en el altar se convirtió en un niño. Cuando un monje dubitativo recibía el pan consagrado, recibía un bocado de carne ensangrentada. Exclamó: "Señor, creo que este pan es tu carne y este cáliz es tu sangre".

La doctrina de la transustanciación dice que el pan y el vino se convierten en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesucristo. Esto sucede cuando el sacerdote dice "Tomen y coman todos de él, porque esto es mi cuerpo, que será entregado por ustedes." Y cuando el sacerdote ora sobre el vino "Tomen y beban todos de él, porque este es el cáliz de mi sangre, sangre de la alianza nueva y eterna, que será derramada por ustedes y por muchos para el perdón de los pecados. Hagan esto en conmemoración mía."

### Mission Appeal on August 6-7

The Catholic University of Cameroon (CATUC), Bamenda is the highest Catholic institute of learning in the English-speaking sector of Cameroon. In her ten years of existence, both staff and students have had a great experience of evangelization with many getting baptized, making their First Holy Communion, getting confirmed, getting married, celebrating the sacraments, answering to religious life and priestly vocations, "and the good news is preached to the poor," thanks to the facilities and services put in place by the Bishops and Board of Trustees to enhance the Catholic witness to the Good News in the Catholic University of Cameroon.

In response to the situation of insecurity that has been orchestrated by the ongoing war in the English-speaking sector of Cameroon since 2016. It has claimed the lives of two teachers of the University, the abduction for ransoms of staff and students with thousands of other numerous killings, close to a hundred thousand displaced in the area, numerous rapes, stealing and torture in town. The need for a secured restaurant and dormitory facility to serve both staff and students has become pertinent and urgent. It will save the vulnerable, especially the young women from all sorts of trouble, contain a large portion of the university population, increase living standards, and limit the itch among Cameroonian students to get out of the country for good. The search for what to eat and where to live has landed many into trouble and the University needs help to provide a facility that would fulfill Our Lord's injunction to "shelter the homeless," and "give them something to eat yourselves."

### Apoyo a la Mision del 6 al 7 de agosto

La Universidad Católica de Camerún (CATUC), Bamenda es el instituto católico de aprendizaje más alto en el sector de habla inglesa de Camerún. En sus diez años de existencia, tanto el personal como los estudiantes han tenido una gran experiencia de evangelización con muchos bautizándose, haciendo la Primera Comunión, confirmando, casándose, celebrando los sacramentos, respondiendo a la vida religiosa y vocaciones sacerdotales, "y la buena nueva se predica a los pobres", gracias a las instalaciones y servicios establecidos por los obispos y la Junta de Síndicos para mejorar el testimonio católico de la Buena Nueva en la Universidad Católica de Camerún.

En respuesta a la situación de inseguridad que ha sido orquestada por la guerra en curso en el sector de habla inglesa de Camerún desde 2016. Ha cobrado la vida de dos profesores de la Universidad, el secuestro para rescate de personal y estudiantes con miles de otros numerosos asesinatos, cerca de cien mil desplazados en la zona, numerosas violaciones, robos y torturas en el pueblo. La necesidad de un restaurante seguro y un dormitorio para servir tanto al personal como a los estudiantes se ha vuelto pertinente y urgente. Salvará a los vulnerables, especialmente a las mujeres jóvenes, de todo tipo de problemas, contendrá a una gran parte de la población universitaria, aumentará el nivel de vida y limitará la ansiedad entre los estudiantes cameruneses por salir del país para siempre. La búsqueda de qué comer y dónde vivir ha causado muchos problemas y la Universidad necesita ayuda para proporcionar una instalación que cumpla con el mandato de Nuestro Señor de "albergar a las personas sin hogar" y "Denles algo de comer".
