The Lion's Roar

Dear friends,

Just recently, I read an article written by Fr. Terrance Klein, a priest of the Diocese of Dodge City, enumerating some concrete measures so that laypeople can have a better experience with the homily at Mass.

"1. Look at the preacher. Even in large churches, the person preaching scans the faces of congregants. I find immediate encouragement comes from seeing faces turned towards me.

Keeping your eyes on the preacher also helps him to better read the room, if you will. Some groups are more responsive than others. Sometimes differences can be felt even among the crowds at the various Mass times at the same parish. Preachers' expectations of how they will be received vary even if they are not explicitly conscious of them, and they often adjust accordingly. For example, if a crowd at a particular Mass tends not to be inclined to laugh, this may contribute to why your preacher rarely attempts to insert a little humor into homilies.

2. Do not read during the homily. It is hard not to view this as a way of silently screaming at the preacher, "I want nothing of this!" Why else would the bulletin or the hymnal suddenly become that interesting? Maybe you do indeed want to say, "I want nothing of this." If so, it is better to make an appointment and explain your perspective to the priest or deacon directly. To the extent that I can, I have altered how I preach in response to negative comments. And the golden rule in the life of any parish is that negative comments should be directed to the person who can respond to them.

It should not need to be noted but picking up your phone while another person is speaking is always rude. In and out of church. Period."

We will continue next week with a few more. Let me know what you think.

Hace poco tiempo, leí un artículo escrito por Padre Terrance Klein, un sacerdote de la diócesis de Dodge City. Dio algunas sugerencias para que los feligreses tuvieran una mejor experiencia con la homilía en la misa.

"Mira al predicador. Aun en una iglesia grande, el predicador ve las caras en la congregación. Me inspira cuando veo las caras me están viendo.

Poniendo su atención al predicador también lo ayuda. Puede saber que clase de grupo esta en su frente. Algunos grupos son más sensibles que otros. A veces se puede sentir la diferencia entre los grupos que asisten a los diferentes horarios de la misa. Si el predicador sepa que clase de gente está en la iglesia, cambia su manera. Por ejemplo, si la gente no se ríe en la misa, el predicador va a evitar todo clase de humor en la homilía.

No lee algo durante la homilía.

Leer algo durante la homilía se puede decir "No quiero nada de esto!" ¿Por que de repente el boletín y el misal son más interesantes? Quizás no quiere la escuchar la homilía. Entonces, haz una cita con el sacerdote o el diacono para hablar sobre esto. Cuando pueda, he cambiado mi manera de dar homilía por los comentarios negativos que he recibido. Y la regla de oro en la vida parroquial es dar los comentarios negativos a la persona que lo correspondan.

Debemos que decir que mirar a tu móvil mientras alguien habla es siempre grosero. En o fuera de la iglesia. Punto."
