### PRIESTHOOD SUNDAY

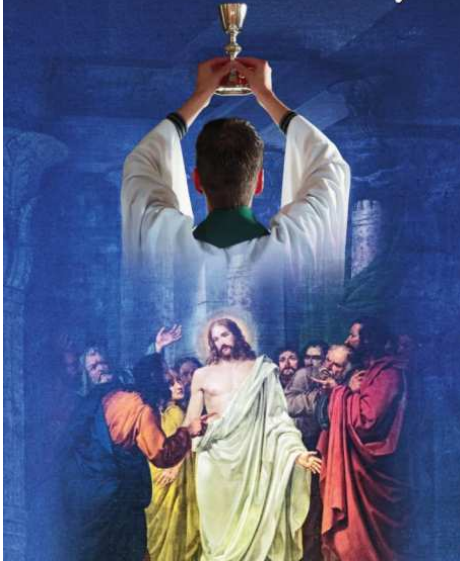

## The Lion's Roar

Dear friends,

Here now is the fifth of the six tips for lay-people for a better homily experience written by Fr. Terrance Klein, a priest of the Diocese of Dodge City.

5. Read the Scriptures before Mass. The General Instruction on the Roman Missal says that the homily "is necessary for the nurturing of Christian life." It instructs the preacher that the homily should be an explanation of some aspect of the readings from Sacred Scripture or of another text from the Ordinary or the Proper of the Mass of the day and should take into account both the mystery being celebrated and the particular needs of the listeners.

In preparing homilies, Catholic preachers are taught to begin with the Scriptures of the day or the meaning of the feast being celebrated. If you, while listening from the pews, cannot find either of these thematic elements in the homily, you should say so.

Homilists are not supposed to exegete the readings, and it would be foolish to attempt to address every meaningful aspect of them in one homily. But if you have read the readings before Mass or pay attention to them as they are proclaimed, you are more likely to recognize and to follow where your homilist is trying to go. Try this: Search for one sentence of the homily that is meaningful to you. Then let the rest go and choose to meditate on the part that worked for you.

Queridos amigos,

Aquí es el quinto consejo de los seis consejos para laicos para una mejor experiencia de homilía escrito por Padre Terrance Klein, sacerdote de la Diócesis de Dodge City.

5. Leer las Escrituras antes de la Misa. La Instrucción General sobre el Misal Romano dice que la homilía "es necesaria para el cultivo de la vida cristiana".

Instruye al predicador que la homilía debe ser una explicación de algún aspecto de las lecturas de la Sagrada Escritura o de otro texto del Ordinario o del Propio de la Misa del día y debe tener en cuenta tanto el misterio que se celebra como las necesidades particulares de los oyentes.

Al preparar las homilías, a los predicadores católicos se les enseña a comenzar con las Escrituras del día o el significado de la fiesta que se celebra. Si usted, mientras escucha desde las bancas, no puede encontrar ninguno de estos elementos temáticos en la homilía, debe decirlo.

Se supone que los homilistas no deben hacer exégesis de las lecturas, y sería una tontería intentar abordar todos los aspectos significativos de ellas en una sola homilía. Pero si ha leído las lecturas antes de la Misa o les presta atención a medida que se proclaman, es más probable que reconozca y siga a donde su predicador está tratando de llegar. Intente esto: busque una oración de la homilía que sea significativa para usted. Luego deja ir el resto y elige meditar en la parte que funcionó para ti.
