Thus, for several years the Vocation Office for our diocese has maintained a fleet of cars that the seminarians use to get to and from their seminary. Some seminaries are quite a distance away, such as St. Paul, MN, and these cars are quickly aging. For those that are closer to home at Mundelein Seminary in Chicago, these cars also help the men visit our parishes on the weekend, aiding greatly in their formation to be priest. In addition to this, having a car allows the seminarian to visit his family easier, all of which helps in his formation to one day be a happy, healthy and holy priest. The Lion's Roar

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. But in the Gospel from Saint Luke, we hear an account of the crucifixion of Jesus, during which he is mocked by rulers, soldiers, and even one of the criminals crucified with Him. The King of the Universe is mocked, beaten, and killed.

This is a reminder to us about the power of Jesus, what His reign really looks like. Jesus reigns not with a show of force that compels people to fall down and worship Him, but with love and mercy. He freely offers Himself on the cross for our salvation and extends forgiveness to the criminal who professes faith in Him.

Our life as Christians, followers of Jesus, is to extend His reign throughout the whole earth. We do this not with worldly power, not with arguments, not with grand shows of force, but with love and mercy. We are to offer ourselves to the people in front of us each day with patience, humility, and love, after the example of our King, crucified and risen. Long live Christ the King!

Reflecting on the Word

Jesus is not the type of king that has lived his life in a palace and been served. He is the type of king that was born where animals live, worked throughout his life, served the sick and poor, and then gruesomely died like a criminal. But Jesus then rose from the dead to bring us new life in him. This king lived like his people so that we may always know that whatever we are going through, whatever pain we are feeling, he understands. God allowed it to happen because "God so loved the Word that he gave his only Son" (John 3:16 NRSV). What a king we have!
