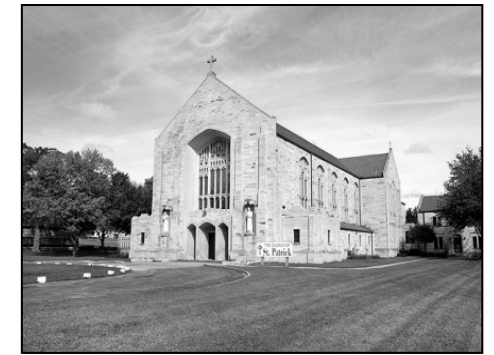
We will have many varieties of Italian Cookies to choose from including Italian Fig Cookies

## The Lion's Roar

Dear friends,

On December 12<sup>th</sup>, the church celebrates the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The famous image is very visible in our church, and it is rich in meaning.

THE LADY STOOD IN FRONT OF THE SUN. She was greater than their dreaded sun-god "Huitzilopochtli".

HER FOOT RESTED ON THE CRESCENT MOON. She had clearly vanquished foremost deity of the Aztecs, the feather serpent "Quetzalcoatl".

THE STARS STREWN ACROSS THE MANTLE. She was greater than the stars of heaven which they worshipped. She was a virgin and the Queen of the heavens for Virgo rests over her womb and the northern crown upon her head. She appeared on December 12, 1531, for the stars that she wore are the constellation of stars that appeared in the sky that day! (Source: Dan Lynch)
