Reflecting on the Word

Today, however, we hear that he is not only the shepherd, but also the lamb. During the Passover in Egypt, the Jewish people offered a sacrifice of a lamb so that they would be saved. Jesus became the sacrificial lamb, the lamb that offers his whole self so that we may be saved and live eternally with him in heaven. What Jesus has for us that he is both our shepherd and our sacrificial lamb.
