Dear friends,

Some youth in our parish were recently Confirmed. This is a wonderful time to recall the effects of the sacrament of Confirmation. The catechism teaches: It is evident from its celebration that the effect of the sacrament of Confirmation is the full outpouring of the Holy Spirit as once granted to the apostles on the day of Pentecost.

From this fact, Confirmation brings an increase and deepening of baptismal grace:

- it roots us more deeply in the divine filiation which makes us cry, "Abba! Father!";
- it unites us more firmly to Christ;
- it increases the gifts of the Holy Spirit in us;
- it renders our bond with the Church more perfect;
- it gives us a special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith by word and action as true witnesses of Christ, to confess the name of Christ boldly, and never to be ashamed of the Cross. (1302-1303)

Queridos amigos,

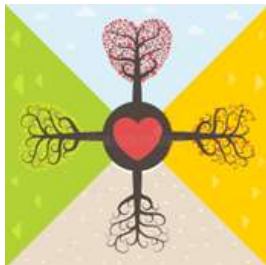

Reflecting on the Word

The list in today's Gospel is called the Beatitudes. The word Beatitude means "blessedness", or "happiness." Just like Jesus tends to do, he takes what most scorn or see as a burden and call it blessed. Those who mourn, who are meek, or who show mercy are blessed because God is with those who need him. Being poor in spirit is not about having a weak spirit but rather knowing that you need God, recognizing that all that you have comes from him and not from yourself. Jesus desires for us to make him the center of our lives and recognize that everything else flows out of his abundant love for us.

Have your family make a list of all their blessings. Pray together thanking God, as he is the source of each of these blessings. Throughout the week, have members add to the list as they recognize more blessings in their lives.
