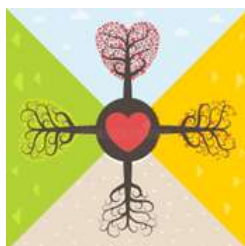

Today's Gospel is an excerpt from Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. He restates commandments but calls us to take them even further. They are not about following the rules God has laid before us but about living in wisdom and truth that will set us free. If our focus is on loving God, our neighbor, and ourselves then we have embraced the heart of what Jesus is calling us to. The commandments are no longer about what we are "supposed" to do or not supposed to do, but about truly loving with whole selves. This is the deeper conversion Jesus longs for us to have.
