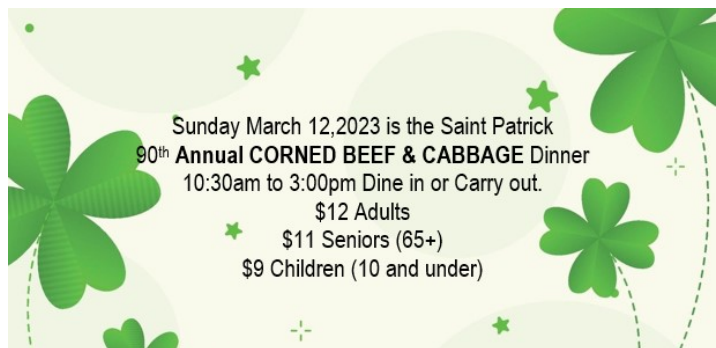

Reflecting on the Word

Begin a Christian is not passive. We cannot sit and watch the word and not be a part of it. As Christians we are called to be the "salt of the earth" and the "light of the word." Salt is not made to sit in a bowl and never be used. Its purpose is to be added to food for flavor. Light also is meant to push away the darkness. Jesus calls us to take the light that we have received from his love and let it touch every part of our life and the lives of those around us. We are called to bring flavor, to transform the darkness into light with our lives.

Living the Word

Reread today's Gospel together with visual: light a candle and place it under a basket. With the lights in the room off, ask your family to share what they observe about the light. Then remove the candle from under the basket and place it on a counter or footrest or table and share your observations again. What new insights does anyone have about the Gospel when they see what happens to the lit candle?
