Reflecting on the Word

I wonder what it was like for these two disciples to walk, discuss, and break bread with Jesus. To listen to him discuss the Scriptures with them. To watch him take the bread, bless it, break it, and give it to them as he did during the Last Supper, and then realize it was Jesus with them. What an experience! At Mass, we also experience what these two disciples experienced on the road to Emmaus. During the Liturgy of the Word, we hear the Scripture proclaimed and broken open for us. During the Liturgy of the Eucharist, the bread is taken, blessed, broken, and given to us. We can experience an Emmaus moment every Sunday!

Living the Word

Sometime during this week, go for a walk as a family. Talk about what the disciples might have been wearing, what shoes they might have had, if you think the walk would have been easy for them. At some point in the walk, stop and read today's Gospel. Then discuss on the way home what it would have been like and talk with Jesus on your walk!
