Reflecting on the Word

Today's Gospel takes place during the Last Supper and reveals some of Jesus' final words to his disciples. During these last moments with them he speaks those famous words, "I am the way, the truth, and the life." Throughout human history, people have always had many different paths they could choose for themselves, but here Jesus is saying he is the right path. As on all paths, however, you must pay attention so that you do not stray from it. You must know and recognize who Jesus is to know how to follow his way. When we spend time with him in Scripture and in prayer, we learn to recognize him and his truth so that our lives follow his.
